



***The new headquarters of the real estate company OR.SA 2000, created in a former industrial area to a design by Ricardo Bofil, satisfies the multiple demands of performance and corporate image, thanks to the versatile expressive language of Haworth furnishing solutions.***

*In center of the city of Savona, an entire former industrial area was recently redesigned and enhanced by the design projects of the Spanish architect, Ricardo Bofil. He added a new transport network, a new entrance to the harbor area, a prestigious real estate complex with large open spaces and a new access to the tourist harbor. OR.SA 2000 is a real estate company that developed the requalification project of the entire area and opened the new two-floor facility inside the main building, completely glass-paneled and overlooking the sea. The interior design project, again by Ricardo Bofil, arranged the operative offices on the second floor with the third floor houses the presidential offices, the management facilities, the meeting room, and the technical office. These modern spaces with their clean design, neutral shades and airy ambience created by the large windows, dominate the desire to communicate prestige, efficiency and maximum transparency of the shapes and the contents. The new layout is a combination of private and shared spaces, blending the management facilities with its associated need for privacy and the operative areas which are synonymous with information exchange and communication. The versatility of the Haworth furnishings was an essential element in the overall arrangement. The main objective of the design was to preserve maximum transparency and permeability of the workplace towards the inside and towards the outside to allow people inside to fully enjoy the scenographic view of the sea and the boats moored just a few yards away. The innovative versatile system of interior partition walls Esedra3 is available in a range of versions and used for a number of different functions. They enhance the prestigious corporate image and provide an appropriate solution for privacy and shared facilities. The esthetic features and the structural solidity of Esedra 3 are joined by excellent performance in terms of high quality acoustic insulation and environmental sustainability. Haworth also designed the seating S-CON belonging to the LC series selected for the presidential offices, the ergonomic seating Zody System 89 for the management offices and the model Very Task used in the operative zones, energized by white and blue furniture pieces. The furnishings include individual work stations, benches, conference arrangements management tables, and the worktops represent all of the variations of the Kiron system. The storage containers belong to the Hugò series. All of the products used are functional and versatile and manufactured with recycled and recyclable materials and inject maximum versatility in the different workplace arrangements.*
